

- 3 Stars Hotel in Bakuriani "PAPA NOEL" (https://planetofhotels.com/en/georgia/bakuriani/papa-noel-hotel)
- double rooms only, with bathrooms;
- full board; conference room, coffee breaks with snacks and cookies;
- table tennis and billiard, Garden, Forest front of The hotel;
- Vegetarian food, Vegan Food, Special diet;
- The hotel supports additional needs if any;

Due to extraordinary times we live in: Host organization took extra measures in order to adapt our project to contemporary world's realities, challenges and needs of our participants:

- All safety standards regarding COVID are observed and there is maximum mobilization from host organziation;
- The hotel where actual training will take a place is fully compliant with COVID-related needs
- In all respective areas of the project venue, have sprays, masks, hand sanitizers, antiseptic napkin, dezobarriers etc.;

Our HOST organizations has 6 years of experience in organizing Erasmus+ project, our team has professional trainers and logistical members, and we always approach our team with professional and quality standards for our projects. During COVID time (in 2021 -2022) we organized 8 ERASMUS + projects in Bakuriani





Project Aim and objectives.

COVID-19 Crisis has changed the world, we need to face reality, especially young people have been affected by these changes. From early 2020 to the present due to the ongoing pandemic and wars, citizens from around the world have experienced high levels of stress, increased tension due to isolation, sickness, helplessness, lack of individual control and countless many. Around two-thirds of students surveyed (65.3%), indicating they were learning 'significantly less' or 'slightly less' since the start of the pandemic. (UN statistics). According to data from the OECD 90% of youth entrepreneurs reported a negative impact on their business due to the pandemic. Distribution and supply chains and reduced customer demand, with 1/4th of the surveyed youth entrepreneurs having to shut down their businesses completely. Among many things, the economy and employment remain topics of strong influence under the pandemic.



Our project "Your case for success" - The project's aim is to share and teach newly created tools regarding the topic of Social Entrepreneurship to organizations and youth workers from the EU and EaP countries to distribute our knowledge, tools and methodologies.



Objectives of the Project

The general objectives of the project are:

- To promote knowledge about social entrepreneurship and its potential benefits for young people;
- To get to know the best practices of successful social entrepreneurship that reduced the Unemployment level and to inspire participants in the field;
- encourage entrepreneurship among young people by stimulating resourcefulness and creativity;
- To reduce the migration of young people from EAP countries In Developed EU countries because of low employment rates and economic problems.
- To increase motivation and leadership skills.
- To equip youth workers and then youth organizations with, tools, methodologies, and techniques to develop projects on the promotion of social entrepreneurship;
- Creating networking among young people of the EU and Eastern Partnership Countries.

Practical information

- In April in Bakuriani is the cold season, from 7-19 Celsius., and as Bakuriani is located in the mount, ains it can be very cold during the evenings, so please bring with you warm clothes
- Plase also take: personal care products, such as shower gel, shampoo, comb, etc.
- If it is possible, please bring laptops, as it can be useful during workshops, personal work during The project.
- Currency in Georgia is lari (GEL) 1 euro = 2,8 GEL
- From the Airport to the city center (liberty Square) there is 1 bus N37 and it costs 0.5 Gel (0.18 Eurocent)
